On February 4 Kiev hosted the public hearings, where one of the topics was Ratification of the ILO Maritime Labor Convention, 2006. At the invitation of the Public Council under the Ministry of Social Policy, the First Vice Chairman MTWTU Oleg Grygoriuk participated in the abovementioned meeting.

Once again all participants of the public hearings took unanimous decision on soonest ratification of the ILO MLC, 2006, thus fulfilling the provisions of the Action Plan for the implementation of the European Union Association Agreement.
