Partnership for the sake of progress: Odessa hosted the 4<sup>th</sup> International Forum on Seafarers' Education Training and Crewing

On April 20-21, 2016 for the fourth time already there was held the International Forum on Seafarers' Education Training and Crewing (ETC-2016) at the premises of the Exhibition Complex of Odessa Sea Commercial Port. Since 2013, the Odessa international maritime forum is included in the calendar of the most significant events in the field of training and employment of marine specialists. This was made possible thanks to the grandiose joint investment project of the International Maritime Employers' Council (IMEC) and the Marine Transport Workers' Trade Union of Ukraine, with the support of Marlow Navigation crewing company.

KSMA, through cooperation between IMEC and MTWTU, has received a grant in the amount of 2,2 million USD for the establishment of unique training laboratory. These funds have been used to purchase a full mission TRANSAS DP offshore simulator, a desktop engine room simulator suite, mission engine room and a GMDSS simulator suite.
