









ABOUT THE PROJECT





The Marine Transport Workers' Trade Union of Ukraine and German trade union ver.di have been enjoying fruitful and mutually-beneficial cooperation for as long as 20 years. During this time and within the Memorandum signed by the parties, there has been implemented a large number of social projects designed for the benefit of Ukrainian seafarers.

In all its activities, the MTWTU aims to change the life of seafarers for better regardless of where they are, at sea or on shore. Research conducted by the MTWTU on the needs of Ukrainian seafarers has shown that one of the key needs at the moment is quality medicine, and especially dental care.



Research conducted by the MTWTU on the needs of Ukrainian seafarers has shown that one of the key needs at the moment is quality medicine, and especially dental care. In the open seas, a sudden toothache can disrupt all work plans, and a seafarer cannot count on an emergency dentist. After all, for example, a small spot on a tooth noticed while on shore and ignored can turn into a painful cavity that usually takes much longer to heal. That is why it is extremely important to make sure your teeth are in good condition before a seafarer leaves for the contract.

Concerned for the health and well-being of seafarers, the unions have launched a joint 'Union Dent' project providing access to free onshore dental services to Ukrainian seafarers working onboard the vessels of German shipowners, which are covered by the ver.di collective bargaining agreements.











PROJECT LAUNCH





The start date of the 'Union Dent' is October 18, 2021, when the partners officially inaugurated the project in Odessa, Ukraine.







During this time 44 trade union members became participants of the project: they received many different dental services of various complexity: from dental examination and sanitation of the oral cavity to prosthetics.

- Internal Passport
- Tax Identification Number

Sign the appropriate service agreement.

See a doctor and get your treatment plan (if necessary).
