AND ANNOUNCEMENT OF NEW PROJECT

The Open Day of Kherson State Maritime Academy was organized at the Maritime Union Center of the MTWTU.

The applicants had the opportunity to get acquainted with the joint project of KSMA and Lithuanian Maritime Academy with the support of the MTWTU and ITF Seafarers' Trust, which aims to train cadets from the 2023 intake.

The project will provide 10 sponsored places for cadets who will enter KSMA in the 2023-2024 academic year. The project will cover the cost of the first year of study at both universities, as well as accommodation at the Academy's campus in Klaipeda.

Cadets will be selected to participate in the project if they meet the sponsors' criteria, including the average competitive score at admission to the university, level of English language proficiency, and additional skills and talents.
