The war has changed reality, but it has not changed us. With the beginning of the full-scale invasion, the MTWTU expanded its work while remaining true to its mission — to stand by Ukrainian seafarers, wherever they are. That is why, from the very first days of the war, the Union developed procedures to provide comprehensive support to seafarers, MTWTU members, and their families located outside Ukraine.

Since 2022, the Marine Transport Workers' Trade Union of Ukraine has provided over ₾63 million in assistance to more than 3,500 seafarers and their families. This is not about money. It's about trust, support, and human destinies, in which we have become a reliable force in the most difficult times.

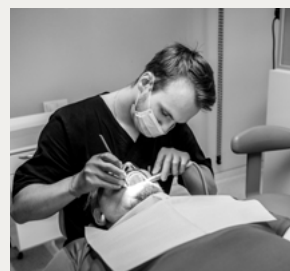

We reacted quickly. We worked in the face of blackouts, shelling, and losses. And we continued to treat, support and rescue.

IMPORTANT:

Reimbursement of medical expenses is available and has almost no exceptions, apart from insured accidents occurring during the voyage. The MTWTU, together with the Welfare Fund of Maritime Transport "MORTRANS", provide assistance in cases of oncological diseases, dental treatment, and planned operations, such as joint replacement, etc.*

*It is subject to the availability of medical grounds and all required documents; each application is processed individually

We don't count our efforts. We count only one thing: how many more people we need to help.

STORIES THAT WILL REMAIN IN THE HEARTS

ODESA

A member of our Union had their home struck twice by Russian missiles. The apartment was destroyed. A roof over his head, basic necessities — everything was lost. Outside, it was winter. We provided a sleeping bag, warm clothes, a flashlight, and a powerful power bank. The seafarer also received substantial financial aid.

GERMANY

A seafarer's son was diagnosed with a chronic illness — psoriasis. The Union covered the treatment costs to ensure the boy received the necessary care without interruption.

TURKEY

A seafarer's little daughter broke her arm. The MTWTU promptly covered the cost of treatment in a foreign clinic.

KHERSON

A seafarer was killed in military action. The Union provided financial, legal and psychological assistance to his family.



POLAND

A seafarer's mother is struggling with diabetes, his father is a disabled patient, his son has autism, his sister has oncology, and her husband was killed in the war. The MTWTU provides comprehensive support to this family, helping them to overcome difficulties every day.

ROMANIA

A seafarer is fighting against oncology, which requires expensive treatment. The Union provides financial aid to give him a chance for recovery.

MARIUPOL — ODESA


A seafarer from occupied Mariupol escaped from the war with his seriously ill mother, young child and pregnant wife. The Union supported this family financially on their way to a new and safe life.

KHERSON

During the occupation, russian forces beat the seafarer, causing serious head injuries. He now requires ongoing treatment and constant care. With his home destroyed, he has been forced to live in a basement. The MTWTU is providing him with essential financial support.

EXPENSES THAT ARE COVERED UNDER THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT

- Providing assistance during challenging situations such as prolonged voyage delays and unforeseen circumstances like accidents, document loss, etc;
 - Assistance related to the birth of a child;
 - Reimbursing expenses related to the funeral process;
 - Financial assistance for medical treatment in-patient and out-patient clinic (including diagnostics, laboratory tests, narrow specialist consultations, medication, surgeries and stay);
 - Reimbursement of medical treatment costs borne by the seafarers, who are unable to cross the border and work at sea, and members of their families.

UNION DENT PROJECT

Dental services are provided to seafarers as part of the MTWTU initiative at the clinic located in Odesa at 9 Arcadian Plateau.

UNION DENT is a modern dental clinic that was established by the MTWTU in partnership with other organizations in 2019. The clinic is equipped with state-of-the-art equipment, and the doctors have extensive experience and an innovative approach to treatment.



DENTAL SERVICES PROVIDED UNDER THE UNION DENT PROJECT:

- Consultation with a specialist without a treatment plan;
- CT scan of both jaws;
- Professional cleaning, ultrasound, and air-flow treatment;
- Tooth filling with the placement of a rubber dam and infiltration, nerve block, and/or topical anesthesia;
- Tooth extraction and suturing (emergency cases).



THE FOLLOWING SERVICES ARE NOT COVERED UNDER THE UNION DENT PROJECT:

- Endodontic treatment;
- Prosthodontics;
- Orthodontics;
- Implantation;
- Teeth whitening and other cosmetic dentistry services.

DURING MARTIAL LAW IN UKRAINE, MEDICAL TREATMENT MAY BE PROVIDED TO A SEAFARER'S SPOUSE AND CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 18 AS A SUBSTITUTE FOR THE SEAFARER HIMSELF/HERSELF.

HOW TO APPLY TO THE MTWTU

 Membership in the MTWTU is a constitutional requirement to receive benefits.
